

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TICKET HOLDERS

The Zbigniew Brzezinski event is SOLD OUT.

Ticket holders: We want to make sure that you are aware of some **transportation challenges** so you can plan accordingly.

On Sunday at 2:00 pm, the [Chinese New Year Parade](#) will begin to work its way through Chinatown. **Parking is NOT allowed along the parade route**, and some **streets will be closed**. [Please click here](#) to read about the closures in detail. The [streets that will be affected](#) between 1:30 – 3:30 pm include:

- I Street, NW from 5th Street to 7th Street, NW
- 7th Street, NW from I Street to G Street, NW
- G Street, NW from 7th Street to 9th Street, NW
- 8th Street, NW from G Street to H Street, NW
- H Street, NW from 8th Street to 6th Street, NW
- 6th Street, NW from Massachusetts Avenue to G Street, NW

The parade begins right near the entrance to Sixth & I on I Street NW, but once the block of I Street between 6th and 7th Streets clears (we're told by 2:30 pm), the street will still remain closed. At this time, however, the sidewalks should clear of spectators and you should have easier access to the building.

We will open doors at 1:30 pm for those who want to arrive early.

There is also **construction on the Red Line metro**—buses will replace trains between Van Ness and Dupont Circle. Woodley Park and Cleveland Park will be closed for track work. If you want to avoid the metro altogether, some buses that stop in Chinatown include the 42, 80, P6, X2, and the Georgetown-Union Station Circulator. That said, buses will also be affected by the street closures related to the parade.

We look forward to a great event, and we'll do everything we can to make entry as smooth as possible given the challenges.
